Hey Ya'll!

Thanks to you, the new Many Point Heritage Fund continues to grow! In 2023 we added over \$45,000 in additional cash gifts given by 21 donors which includes a generous gift from a Twin Cities Troop! This puts the cash balance in the fund at \$211,000 with estimated committed estate gifts of over \$2 million dollars. We are well on our way to our initial \$10 million dollar goal!

THANK YOU to everyone that has given thus far, and

to those of you who are planning to give toward a *forever* fund for camp!

This past summer we created large HERITAGE posters for each subcamp and the main area. The idea was to share the initiative with scouts, leaders, and staff with the simple message that everyone can participate in protecting and expanding the future of camp, and that camp will be forever grateful.

Vanderbilt as the new Heritage Activities Coordinator. Since then, Drew has accepted a job as Development *Director* for the *Thomas Jefferson Monticello Historic Monument* in Charlottesville, Virginia. Drew is applying what he's learning there on the Heritage Fund activity strategy.



Many Point boasts the largest fleet of AMF Sunfish Sailboats, with some of these vessels tracing their roots back to the 1970s. These sailboats Sunfish have been a staple of Many Point's waterfront activities. Not only have they weathered countless waves and hours of wind but have also been a key Waterfront Legacy element in creating lasting memories for generations of Scouts.

Brief History of **AMF** Sunfish Sailboats: The AMF Sunfish, designed by Alcort, Inc. in 1952, quickly became a popular choice for recreational sailing. Its simplicity, durability, and ease of use made it an ideal boat for beginners while providing enough excitement for seasoned sailors. Many Point's fleet, acquired over the years, has become an integral part of the camp's identity, symbolizing the Spirit adventure and camaraderie. Many Point has the largest fleet of these sailboats.

WAYS TO HELP MANY POINT

ROSTER UPDATES!

In Memory of:

In 2022 several former Many Point Staff members passed away. For many of them Many Point was a pivotal part of their lives that not only created heartwarming memories but provided opportunities and events that shaped their lives! Indeed, they became who they became because of Many Point! Many Point needs to continue to exist so that it can help more young people become actualized — become the best person they can be.

It has been suggested that memorials given to the Many Point Heritage Endowment Fund, in the name of a staff member who has passed away, are a wonderful way to continue the memory of a former staff person. We saw this done this year and thought it should be shared with all former staff. What a great way to memorialize the life of a former staff member! Memorials and other donations enable Many Point to continue its mission and to help future staff and Scouters have their lives shaped by the experience of Many Point! When you are touched by the death of a former staff member consider memorializing their lives through the Many Point Heritage Endowment Fund.

IRAS and You

If you have an Individual Retirement Account (IRA) you recognize that you must take a Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) at a specified age. Congress has acted to gradually increase that age. It was 72 in 2022 and moves to age 73 in 2023 and in 2033 it jumps to 75. There are penalties for not taking the RMD. When one takes a distribution from an IRA - it counts as income in that year so it is taxed. Also, as income it could raise your tax level and impact Medicare expenses. Those events can be avoided.

You can work with your IRA account manager and make a

Charitable Distribution (QCD) and avoid both the taxes and the impact upon your Adjustable Gross Income (AGI). This is a powerful tool and was made permanent in 2015. If you are making contribution to the Many Point Alumni Association or the Many Point Heritage Endowment Fund you may want to consider this path. Even if you have not made contributions before it may prove to a useful strategy for your financial planning. Besides you are making the world better by helping Many Point and what it does to make vouth become better citizens and people!


